



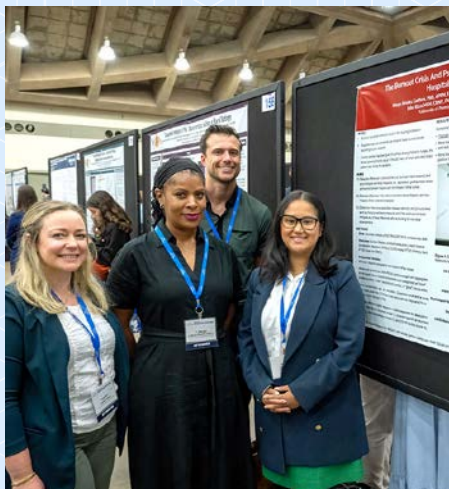
Senior Fellow Benefits
